Road safety policy priorities for the Transport Safety APPG

Following the discussion with Ruth Cadbury MP, Co-Chair of Transport Safety APPG, PACTS has produced this short paper suggesting policy priorities for the APPG. It is currently for discussion. PACTS has set out below its priorities as a basis for discussion of priorities for the APPG.

- 1. Road Safety Investigation Branch Legislation to establish it with investigatory powers.
- 2. **Road Safety Strategic Framework** publish ambitious strategy based on safe system principles, action plan and performance indicators etc.
- 3. Casualty reduction targets based on the UN target of 50% KSI reduction 2020 to 2030
- 4. Vehicle Safety Regulations update GB regulations to world-leading standards
- 5. **Roads policing** response to Call for Evidence and Roads Policing Review. Roads policing to be listed as a Strategic Policing Requirement.
- 6. **Drink Drive** Lower the BAC limit to 50 mg and allow courts to impose alcohol interlocks.
- 7. **Young drivers** graduated driver licensing.
- 8. Infrastructure raise to safe system standards, including provision for pedestrians and cyclists.
- 9. Speed limits 20 mph in urban areas with traffic calming; review of rural road speed limits.
- 10. Penalty points for seat belt non-wearing.
- 11. **E-scooters** publish rental trials evaluation report and legislation.
- 12. Pavement parking- Introduce a national pavement parking ban.
